Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project

Construction Schedule This Week

This week our contractor is going to be grading Alden Way roadway down to grade. Our contractor plans to start working on the sewer main and services on Craigbrook Way. They will be starting on the west side of Craigbrook Way and move east towards East River Road. Temp Water has started for residents that live on the north side of Craigbrook Way. If you have any issues with temp water just let us know.

Gas Main

CenterPoint Energy is replacing the gas main along the north side of Craigbrook Way and on Alden Way for a short stretch. Michel's is their contractor for this work and will be working along our contractor, Peterson Companies for a few weeks.

Rain Events

We received approximately 1.8" of rain over the weekend. There were some issues with the intersection of Craigbrook Way and Alden Way. Our contractor did come out on Sunday night to clean up the area. They will be protecting the roadway as much as they can, but if we do have another rain event with the roadway exposed, please just let us know of any issues and try to avoid any soft/hazard areas.

Temp Mailboxes/Recycling & Garbage Cans

Temporary mailboxes have been placed on the east side of Alden Way just north of Craigbrook Way/Alden Way intersection. Please be cautious of equipment and machinery while walking down Craigbrook Way. Starting next week, our contractor will be taking your trash and recycling cans from your driveway to a location that will be easily accessible for the garbage/recycling trucks.

Safety

We ask that you please not leave any cars on the street during the duration of the project. It causes delays for our contractor and we don't want to cause any damage to your personal vehicles. Please remember to be safe and drive cautiously wherever you see construction warning signs and cones. Follow detours carefully. Do not approach machinery when in operation.
