Stonybrook Trunk Storm Sewer Improvement Project

UPDATED - Concrete Work (Curb/Driveways)

The weather has caused us to push back on the installation of concrete curb. The contractor is string-lining the curb for placement today, but will make sure that you have access to your driveway this week. The contractor plans on installation of concrete curb and concrete driveways on **Monday, August 27th**. **We ask that you please have your vehicles out of your driveway prior to 7:00 am on Monday morning.** This schedule is weather dependent. We will send out updates next week in emails and will put a notice on our project website if the schedule changes in anyway.

Once the curb is installed, **you will not have access to your driveway for one week while concrete cures. There will also be no on-street parking during this period.** If you have overnight parking needs outside of contractor work hours (7:00 am to 7:00 pm), please contact us. We understand this is one more major period of inconvenience, but this will be the last period of access limitation with the exception of short durations for street paving. You may park on Alden Way (outside of the construction area) and any adjacent street while the concrete cures.

The plan for asphalt paving is TBD but we are looking at the possibility of paving at the end of the week or right after labor day (Weather Dependent). The contractor plans on starting to work on restoration of turf and landscaping this week and will continue to do so throughout the paving process.
